

# MortalityLaws Installation

The package can be installed from two different sources, CRAN or GitHub. Most people would choose the first option (see below).

## 1 Install stable version from CRAN

The `MortalityLaws` package can be installed from CRAN as follows:

1. Make sure you have the most recent version of R
2. Run the following code in your R console

```
install.packages("MortalityLaws")
```

## 2 Install development version from GitHub

The latest version can be installed from author's GitHub repository by running the following code in your R console:

```
# install.packages("devtools")  
devtools::install_github("mpascariu/MortalityLaws")
```

In this case you will need to have `devtools` package already installed in order to allow R to connect to GitHub. Otherwise uncomment the first line and install it.

Now you are ready to go. Happy modelling!
